INDIVIDUAL CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION :-

A number of priests will be present. *One parent goes with the child to a priest* and introduces him *"this is......" (child's name)*. The parent stands back and waits until the child goes to Confession.

The priest welcomes the child and then says:- *"tell me some of the times when you strayed from God's love"*.

The child says :- "*I strayed from God's love when*" and ends with "*I am sorry for all my sins*". (One example of straying from God's love is sufficient).

The priest gives the child penance and absolution.

When the child returns from the priest, as a sign of forgiveness, the waiting parent should give him a hug before returning to their seats.

On returning to the seat, the child will say the penance given by the priest.

OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION:-

- 1. Ceremony begins at 11.30a.m. on Saturday, 10th March in <u>St. Anthony's Church.</u>
- 2. St. Anthony's is situated behind the "old" St. Anthony's on the coast road. It may be approached via a lane off St. Lawrence Road, near the Methodist Church on the corner of Clontarf Road / St. Lawrence Road. It is signposted. There is a car park beside and behind the church.
- 3. You may also park on Clontarf Road opposite the "old" St. Anthony's where there is a parking area. You can walk through the grounds of the old church to reach the new one.
- 4. The children will be given particular places. **Two adults may sit with each child**. Other family members should sit in the unreserved seats.
- 5. The children should wear their school tracksuit.
- 6. The ceremony should last approximately one hour.
- 7. The Parents' Association hope to host a little reception in St. Anthony's house immediately after the ceremony.
